

Animals in Need

Overpopulation is the number one problem faced by sheltering agencies today. The blame for this needless suffering lies with people who fail to live up to their responsibilities of dog and cat ownership and care. They allow companion animals to multiply far beyond the capacity of society to adequately provide for them. In seven years one unspayed female and her unspayed descendants can theoretically produce 4,372 offspring. Approximately 12 million dogs and cats are euthanized by animal shelters each year. Why does this problem exist? The two main root causes are (1) irresponsible and accidental breeding and (2) owners who fail to incorporate the pet into the home which results in relinquishment or abandonment.

About Us

Aid To Animals Rescue, Inc. was founded in 1973 as a not-for-profit organization dedicated to saving and improving the lives of homeless and injured animals. Each year we rescue and place hundreds of animals through our various adoption programs. We are committed to reducing the over-population problem through education and low-cost spay and neuter programs.

Reducing Pet Over-Population

Recent advancements in veterinary techniques have allowed for the spaying and neutering of kittens at three months and puppies at four months of age. This has enabled ATA Rescue to spay and neuter all cats and kittens, dogs and puppies prior to placing them in loving homes.

In addition to insuring that our placements do not add to the pet over-population problem, we are fortunate to work with a few generous veterinarians who provide low-cost spaying and neutering through our organization to qualified pet owners who have not adopted from us. For those individuals or families who are unable to afford the cost of spaying and neutering their pets, ATA Rescue provides financial assistance.

Pet Counseling

It has often been said that more suffering is inflicted through ignorance and neglect than through willful cruelty. Our mission is to educate people in the proper care and handling of our furry companions. To ensure the success of our adoptions, we provide free in-home training for our dog placements and counseling for cat behavioral problems.
